100-Mile Dinner "On the Village Green", MOLONG NSW Monday 11 April 2016

WHAT IS IT? The 100-Mile Dinner recognises the wonderful food and produce grown and produced within a 100-Mile

or (160kms) radius around Orange and the importance of eating locally and supporting our local

producers.

The dinner is a communal style dinner held "On the Village Green" in Molong, NSW. Table seating allows friends and strangers to sit side by side and enjoy a degustation menu, with a course from each of the

towns participating in the dinner.

WHEN Monday 11 April 2016

TIME 6:30pm till approximately 10.30pm

COST \$105 for dinner. Wine may be purchased on the night (no BYO). Buses available from Orange \$20 per

person

FOOD A 5 course degustation menu of local produce

BEVERAGES Wine is available for purchase by the glass and/or bottle using a voucher system. Vouchers may be

purchased from a central point at the venue which can then be redeemed for wine at each town's stall

situated around the Village Green.

Coffee will also be available for purchase on the night.

TRANSPORT Pre booked bus transport is available and will pick up passengers from the Orange City Council Car park (at

the rear of the Orange Civic Theatre, Byng Street, Orange). Buses will depart at 6.00pm sharp! Bus tickets

must be purchased in advance and online when you purchase your tickets.

PARKING For those travelling by bus from Orange, parking is available in the council car park – entrance off Lord's

Place and in Molong there is abundant parking on nearby streets.

SEATING Seating is not prearranged. Groups wanting to sit together will need to arrive on time in order to secure a

preferred seat.

MUSIC Music is provided by our wonderful Orange band, "The Trouble with Johnny".

WET WEATHER The 100 Mile Dinner on the Village Green will go ahead rain, hail or shine – our wet weather venue will be

at Printhie Winery, a short distance from Molong. If our wet weather option is activated <u>all guests</u> will be bused to and from Printhie departing from Molong. Details about this procedure will be sent to you via email and mobile SMS messages. Please ensure these details are included and up-to-date with your

booking.
