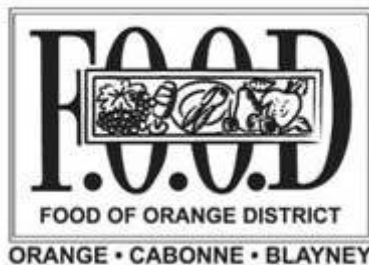

## **Information about the Election of Members to the F.O.O.D Week Committee**

### **What Our Constitution Says:**

#### Composition and Membership of Committee:

The Committee is to consist of:

- the office-bearers of the association (President, Vice President, Treasurer and Secretary)
- a maximum of 5 ordinary members

Each of whom is to be elected at the annual general meeting of the association.

#### Election of Members:

Nominations of candidates for election as office-bearers of the association or as ordinary members of the committee:

- A person nominated as a candidate for election as an office-bearer or as an ordinary committee member of the Association must be a social member or the nominated personal representative of the business member of the Association. For the avoidance of doubt, honorary members are not eligible for election as an office-bearer or as an ordinary committee member of the Association.
- Must be made in writing, signed by two (2) members of the association and accompanied by the written consent of the candidate (which may be endorsed on the form of the nomination) and,
- Must be delivered to the Secretary of the association at least seven (7) days before the date fixed for the holding of the annual general meeting at which the election is to take place.
- If insufficient nominations are received to fill all vacancies on the committee, the candidates nominated are taken to be elected and further nominations are to be received at the annual general meeting.
- If insufficient further nominations are received, any vacant positions remaining on the committee are taken to be casual vacancies.
- If the number of nominations received is equal to the number of vacancies to be filled, the persons nominated are taken to be elected.
- If the number of nominations received exceeds the number of vacancies to be filled, a ballot is to be held.
- The ballot for the election of office-bearers and ordinary members of the committee is to be conducted at the annual general meeting in such usual and proper manner as the committee may direct."
