

INFORMATION & TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR F.O.O.D TRAIN PARTICIPANTS

Event Information:

F.O.O.D Train

Date: Friday 8th April to April 10th, 2022

Limit to the number of tickets purchased:

Allocation of tickets is dependent on member numbers, total tickets etc. Our aim is to provide equitable access to all events for our valued members. Due to the popularity of the Food Train event, there is a limit of **6 tickets per person** for 'Friends of F.O.O.D' Members and **4 tickets per person** for Non-Members. If one person is seen or found to have breached this condition, the second or subsequent purchases will be refunded immediately less the booking fee and credit card charges. (\$20 per ticket).

Covid Restrictions

This event has a Covid Safety Plan and will actively adhere to all the regulations as stipulated by the NSW Government and NSW Health. All Guests must abide by the current NSW Public Health order at the time of the event. These guidelines will be emailed to all guest closer to the event as the pandemic is an evolving situation and the guidelines are subject to change. Eg Mask wearing, vaccination status and Covid 19 Check in requirements.

Should the primary ticket buyer be purchasing tickets on behalf of a group, they are responsible for knowing the contact details of all attendees in their group. If they are contacted directly by the Government including the Department of Health for the purposes of contact tracing, they must: a) make the contact details of their group available to the Government, or b) contact each member of their group, and request that they provide their contact details to the Government directly.

Refunds:

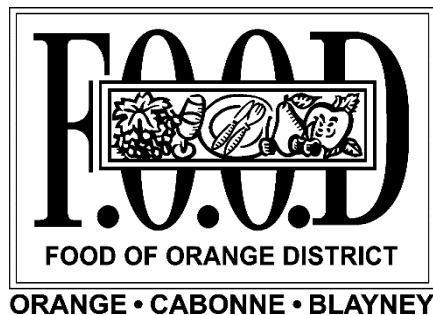
A refund (less \$50per ticket) will be given at purchaser's request BEFORE March 8, 2022. After that date, no refunds will be made.

Please arrive at approximately 30 minutes prior to departure if you wish to book luggage through on train. Luggage space is limited.

What to wear:

Smart Casual/ comfortable shoes. The weather in April is generally delightful but it can change at short notice so a jacket in case of cool or showery conditions could be handy.

Forage Event:

As part of the F.O.O.D Train package, you will be attending Forage. The walk is around 4.1kms and requires only a moderate level of fitness. But being at an altitude of 900 metres it is recommended that people with pre- existing health conditions consult their medical practitioner before booking.

You will be required to travel by bus to the event, and your bus may be shared with other patrons. Please refer to the 2019 Forage - Information and Terms for further information and terms.

Return Travel:
